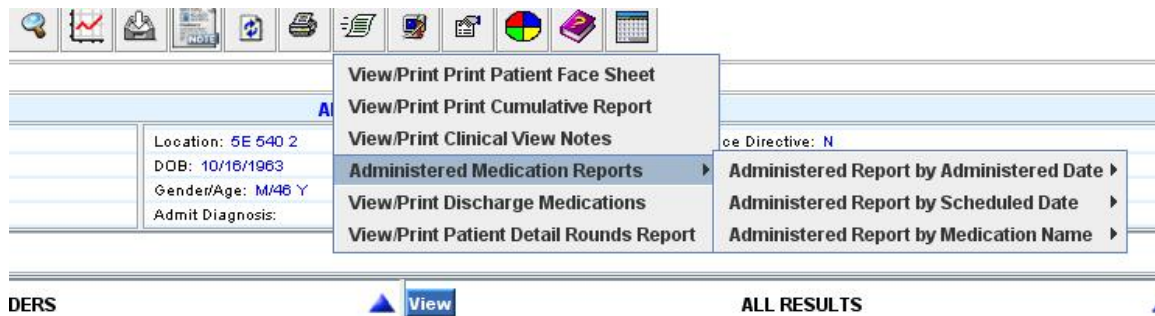
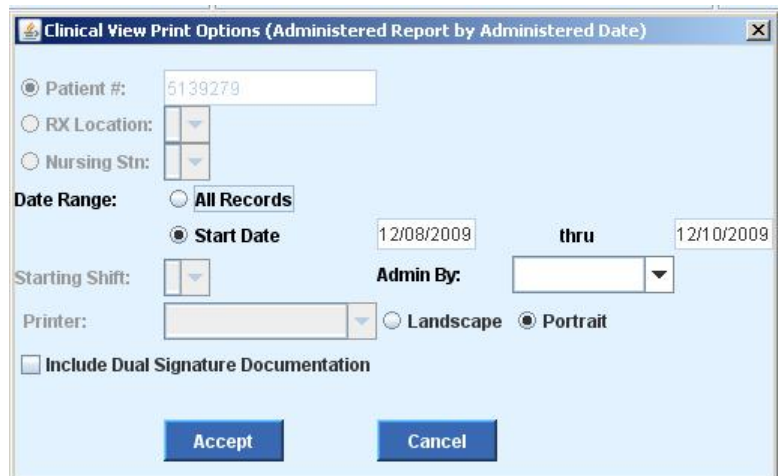


## How to view MARs in HMS

Once you have selected your patient, click on the Report icon. You will have new choices. Select “Administered Medication Reports” and then select the report that you want to view. Your choices are by Administered Date, Scheduled Date, or Medication name.



The report will begin with the date of admission. If you wish to narrow your report, select the dates that you want to look at. Click the ‘Accept’ Button.



Your report will come up in a new window. If you do not see the report, make sure that the window did not pop up underneath your Clinical View window. You can then select a printer if you wish to print the report.

The Pharmacy view will continue to give you the medication profile for your patient.
